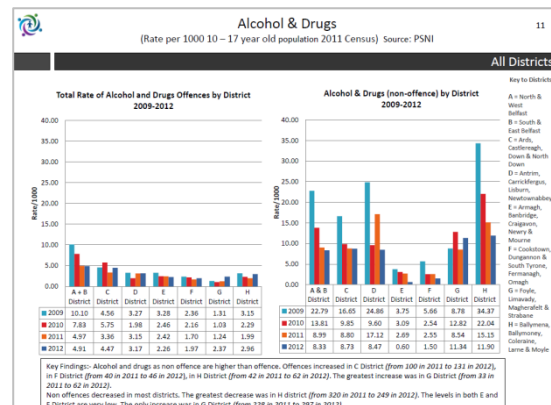
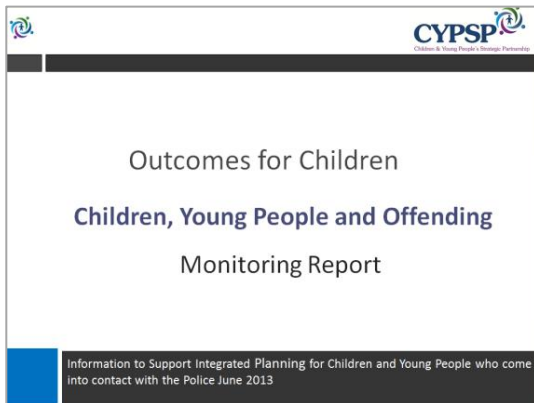


New Monitoring Report developed on Children, Young People and Offending

The Regional Subgroup for Children, Young People and Offending have produced a new monitoring report that presents statistics on offending behaviour in Northern Ireland.



Using information shared by Police Service Northern Ireland (PSNI), this report details offending behaviour of young people across each police district in Northern Ireland. The report provides both a regional overview of offending; by type of offence and police district; and further analysis by police district, age and gender.

This is the first time that this kind of information has been collated and analysed in this level of detail. It provides the CYPSP Regional Sub Group and all relevant agencies and organisations with an extensive resource that will contribute to the evidence informed, outcomes based planning. Trends can be identified and supported with experience and expertise of professionals, children and young people to identify particularly worrying areas or areas of best practice. This tool will also contribute to the extensive and innovative mapping system developed by the CYPSP.
